To whom it may concern,

On Friday, February 9, 2007, Heather Smith brought two dogs to my home my home, one Lab, female, black (Honey) and one Lab/Boxer, male, brown (Bobby). Both were extremely thin, with their ribs clearly visible. Honey's hip bones protruded, and she had what appeared to be bite marks on her head, with the skin showing. Bobby had a sore on the end of his tail, and what appears to be callouses. He also had various abrasions on his back. When fed, both dogs would gulp their food, about 1 cup soaked in water per feeding, in less than 30 seconds. Honey is very timid about going into small rooms, such as the bathroom, and has a difficult time going down stairs. Both dogs are aversive to loud noises, especially voices and Honey will run and hide at these times. Both dogs also will cringe and cower if one raises an arm as if they are fearful of being hit.
